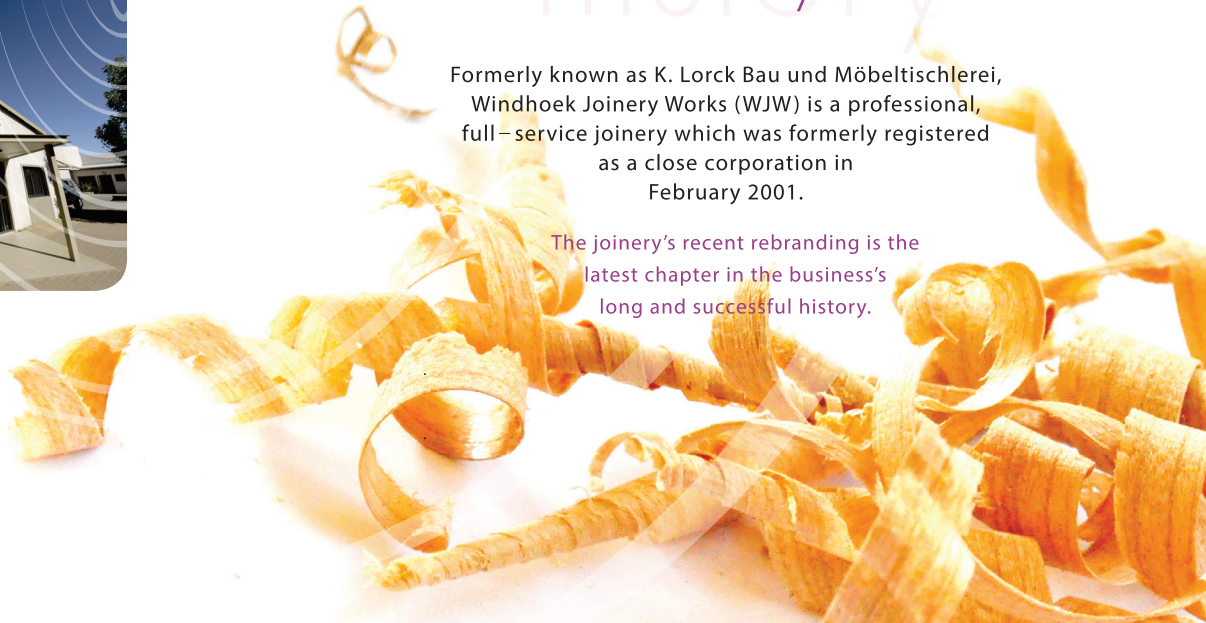

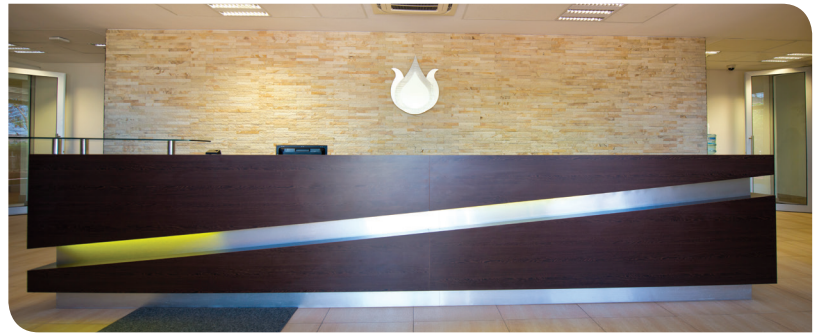


HOW we work
